City of Perth contractors charged

28 November 2014

The Corruption and Crime Commission has charged two City of Perth contractors and the employee of a third contractor with unlawfully disclosing restricted information related to a CCC investigation.

A 51-year-old office partitioning contractor faces four counts of disclosing a restricted matter in relation to his appearance before the Commission for a private examination in March this year.

A 55-year-old plumbing contractor faces three counts of disclosing a restricted matter in relation to his appearance before the Commission, also in March, as part of the same investigation.

The CCC will allege the men separately disclosed restricted information about the private examinations and what they had been asked by the Commission to other persons of interest in the investigation. This was despite being advised that it was an offence to reveal any information about the private examinations.

A 44-year-old man employed by another City of Perth contractor also faces three counts of disclosing a restricted matter in relation to his appearance before the Commission in May this year as part of the same investigation.

The CCC will allege he disclosed information to his employer about the summons he received to appear before the Commission and what was later discussed at the private examination, despite being warned that disclosing any information was an offence.

All three men are due to appear in the Perth Magistrates Court on 10 December.
