Two Custodial Officers stood down as part of a CCC investigation

Two Custodial Officers suspected of engaging in serious misconduct have been stood down from duty as part of a joint investigation conducted by the Corruption and Crime Commission, Department of Justice, WA Police Force, and with assistance from SERCO.

The investigation focusses on improper associations between Custodial Officers and prisoners, and the facilitation of drugs and contraband into WA prisons.

The investigation is continuing and the Commission is conducting private examinations where witnesses may be offered protections provided under the [Corruption, Crime and Misconduct Act 2003](#) if they provide information of value to the investigation.

The Commission urges Custodial Officers and others in the prison system to come forward if they have information useful to the investigation, before the Commission approaches them.
