CCC to hold examinations into the health sector in early 2017

5 December 2016

The Corruption and Crime Commission (CCC) will hold examinations to explore the risk of serious misconduct in the health sector early in 2017. It is important that the community has

complete confidence in its health system.

The decision follows the sentencing today of a senior public servant employed as a pharmacist by the South Metropolitan Health Service, who corruptly accessed drugs at the

tertiary hospital.

He was convicted and sentenced on 46 charges of stealing as a public servant and another

46 of possessing a prohibited drug.

It is anticipated the examinations will include evidence from senior public servants, other

clinicians and professionals working with the public health sector.
