Meekatharra Department of Education employee charged by CCC

12.10.12

A Department of Education employee from Meekatharra has been charged by the Corruption and Crime Commission today with 25 counts of corruption and 13 of stealing as a servant.

It is alleged that between August 2008 and December 2010 the 47-year-old employee used a government credit card to steal goods and services valued at \$5,303. The goods mostly consisted of car parts and clothing.

The corruption charges involve the alleged use of a government account with a courier company to freight personal items to Meekatharra.

The employee is due to appear in Meekatharra Magistrates Court on Wednesday 7 November 2012.
